The 18th November is Children in Need Day and Johnstone High are gearing up for an exciting fundraising comeback after a few years of Covid restrictions spoiling the party.

Events will be running at interval and lunch time each day and will culminate in an appeal show on Friday.

Throughout the week, our pupils can expect to see the following activities taking place:

Each of these activities will cost £1 or less and will be located in the foyer, with the exception of Beat the Goalie and Fear Pong which will take place in the PE Hub.

56 pupils are invited to dress up as "British Icons" on Friday in exchange for a donation towards Children in Need.

Pupils will be encouraged to buy a ticket to the Johnstone High Children in Need appeal shows which will take place on Friday 18th November.

There will be three shows running throughout the day. One during P1 and 2, one during P3 and 4 and the final show will take place during P5 and 6. They will feature talent shows, appeal updates, soak the teacher challenges and various game shows.

Pupils can buy a ticket for individual shows at a cost of £2. If they wish to purchase an all-day ticket, this will be available for £5. Tickets will be on sale in the school foyer every interval this week.

Lessons on Friday will continue as normal during P1-4 and will be replaced with free, classroom-based Children in Need themed activities for all during P5 and 6.
