

## Head Teacher Update Monday 27th February 2023

Dear Parent / Carer.

Here is the news for week beginning Monday 20th February 2023:

- Parent Council took place on Monday evening. Myself and Ms Price met with the group and the main focus was the recent curriculum consultation and proposed options forms for S2 – S5. Over the next few days all Parent Council documentation will be placed on our website. There you can access all previous PC minutes and HT reports.
- 2. On Tuesday we welcomed Graeme Armstrong, author of 'The Young Team', to visit a selected group of seniors as part of the Renfrewshire Book Festival. I had heard Graeme speak before and knew the pupils were in for a treat, and he was superb. Now 31, he spoke to the young people about his life in Coatbridge as a gang member and drug addict, and how he managed throughout this to get some Highers, including English, and go to Stirling University. He's inspirational and the pupils were an excellent audience. They all received a signed copy of his book.
- 3. On Wednesday we welcomed Onatti Theatre Group to the school. They performed a 2-person show, mainly in French, to an audience of over 350 P7 from all seven of our associated primary schools, in addition to our own S1. A well organised event by Miss Gallacher and the Modern Languages team, with great support from both Primary and JHS staff.
- 4. The S5 Young Enterprise group completed their Strathclyde University business exam on Wednesday afternoon. I fully expect to see familiar JHS faces on the Apprentice in years to come.
- 5. Well done to the Music team for getting all the pupils through their SQA Music practical exams this week. The team informed me that the pupils seemed to have performed well; this will set them up for their theory exam in May.
- And finally, this week we celebrated Purple Friday, and as a school community we actively demonstrated - again - our allyship with the LGBTQ+ community.
