Pupil behaviour in school and in the community

Over the past few weeks, we have been receiving complaints from local residents and from the golf course about the conduct of Johnstone High pupils. This will be a small minority of pupils, but nevertheless it damages the reputation of the school within our local community.

In line with all other high schools, our young people are allowed out at lunchtime and break, and school staff supervise in key areas of the grounds / back path. However, we cannot supervise the entire Johnstone area, nor do we have capacity to supervise at all the various shops the young people go to.

If a young person is misbehaving in the community, this will be taken very seriously, and parents / carers will be contacted and sanctions put in place. In the most concerning cases, the community police will also be involved. Therefore, I ask that you discuss behaviour in the community with your child and stress that the responsibility lies with them to behave in an appropriate manner at all times.
